INVITATION:

Photographic Association of Dum Dum cordially invites all the Photographers, Scientists, Technologists and Educationists working in the field of photography anywhere in the world to participate in the 12th International Photographic Conference under the **auspices of FIAP**. We are confident that the conference will be a treat for all.

CLIMATE:

Very pleasant. Temperature is usually 20-22°C during the day, and between 14-16°C at night in Kolkata.

DATE AND VENUE:

The Twelfth International Photographic Conference, sponsored by the Photographic Association of Dum Dum in collaboration with the Birla Industrial & Technological Museum (BITM), National Council of Science Museums, Ministry of Culture, Govt. of India, will be held at BITM Auditorium, 19A, Gurusaday Road, Kolkata 700019 during 23rd-27th January, 2023.

LANGUAGE:

The proceedings of the conference will be conducted mainly in English but provision will be made for interpreting discussions in other languages viz. French, German etc.

PROGRAMME:

The Conference will include Seminar, Workshop, Photo fair and Exhibition. The seminar will include reading of papers, invited lectures and discussions on various aspects of photography broadly in six groups viz. Digital, Scientific & Technical, Pictorial, Educational, Cinematography, Press and General. Detailed programme with timing will be distributed to the delegates at the venue on the eve of the conference.

WORKSHOP

Prior to the conference a workshop will be arranged for limited 20 Indian delegates to be conducted by experts on Digital, Portrait & Creative Photography during 21st-23rd January, 2023. Fees is only rupees two thousand five hundred (2500/-) inclusive of conference fee of rupees one thousand five hundred (1500/-).

PHOTOFAIR EXHIBITION:

A high light of the conference will be an exhibition of photography including some invited prints from eminent artists of the world. The Exhibition and Fair will remain open to the public from 24th to 27th January, 2023 daily between 10:00 A.M to 5:30 P.M.

REFRESHMENT AND ENTERTAINMENT:

Delegates will be served with tea, lunch, coffee, and snacks etc. from time to time, free of charge. There will be also film shows and cultural programme for the entertainment of the delegates. Sightseeing trips will also be arranged. For the foreign delegates tour to Santiniketan, Digha and Darjeeling may be organised on request.

DELEGATESHIP:

Anybody interested in photography may be a delegate provided he or she is introduced by any photographic organisation (viz. Associations, Clubs, Industries, Studios etc.) or reputed photographer in India and abroad or by any University or by any Scientific organisation or Govt. Department in India and abroad and pay the delegate fee of Us \$ 75 / £ 65 / Euro 75/ INR 1500/- etc. Delegates will have the scope to contribute papers to be read at the conference, to propose any resolution beforehand (at least 24 hours before discussion) and to receive free of cost publications by the Association in connection with the conference. Last date for delegate ship is 10th January 2023.

INVITEE:

Many of the internationally renowned persons in different fields of photography are being invited and are expected to participate in the conference.

PRESENTATION OF PAPER:

Those who intend to read papers in the conference are requested to send two copies of their papers neatly typed with double space, A-4 size paper together with an abstract of the same before 31st December 2022. Paper may be sent in CD/DVD in MS Word or by E-mail.

ACCOMMODATION AND TRAIN FARE:

Association will do the needful for food and lodging for the foreign delegates contributing papers or representing countries. Arrangements will be made for food, lodging and 2nd class train fare to the Indian invitees from other states. Organising body will help other delegates for accommodation provided they intimate and pay the necessary charges beforehand. Since a large number of participants are expected, it is particularly requested that the delegates seeking accommodation may kindly write to the Jt. Secretary well in advance, preferably before 31st December 2022.

INDIA AND KOLKATA :
